⁽¹⁾ U6 will play 2v2 "festival format" but may play any format up to 4v4 (1v1, 2v2, 3v3 or 4v4). U9 standard is 7v7 but may play 6v6. U10 standard is 7v7 but may play 8v8. U11-U12 standard is 9v9 but may play 8v8.

⁽²⁾ U9-U10: build out lines are located equidistant from top of each penalty area and halfway line. No offside between build out lines (halfway line to each build out line).

⁽³⁾ U9-U12 (SYA): trailing team can add 1 player if goal differential is 4 or more goals. U14-U19 (NCSL-REC): leading team must remove 1 player for each goal above 4-goal differential. Mercy Rule can be invoked by any U14-U19 team trailing by 4 or more goals.

⁽⁴⁾ SYA Game Facilitator used for U8 and below (no referees). SYA assigns USSF-certified match officials for U9 and above, depending on number of referees available for a game. Club linesmen may be used for any game when requested by the referee. No game shall use 2-person system of control.

⁽⁵⁾ Referees can show yellow/red cards to coaches and team officials for irresponsible behavior. Referees cannot show cards to spectators. Referees should use discretion when showing cards to U9-U12 players.
